A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING RETROACTIVE COMPENSATION FOR THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER FOR PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, Article I, Section 3 of the Charter of the City of Berkeley, Missouri, as adopted in 1957 and amended in 1972, provides that all powers of the city shall be vested in an elective council subject to the Charter and limitations of the Constitution of Missouri, and that the Council shall appoint a City Manager, and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1 of the Charter for the City of Berkeley provides that the Council shall the power to appoint an officer who shall have the Title of City Manager and who shall have the powers and perform the duties provided in the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the position of City Manager has been vacant in the City of Berkeley since September 29, 2016 and the Assistant City Manager has been in main been task to perform the duties of said position; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to compensate the Assistant City Manager for the additional duties and responsibilities he has and continue to perform.

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Berkeley, Missouri as Follows:

SECTION 1 Dr. Terrance Gibson, Assistant City Manager for the City of Berkeley, shall receive the budgeted compensation of the City Manager (\$80,000) retroactive to December 1, 2016.

SECTION 2 This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
