**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 4327 WHICH REQUIRED RESIDENCY OF ALL FULL TIME EMPLOYEES**

**WHEREAS**, on October 03, 2016, the City of Berkeley passed Ordinance #4327 requiring all new full-time employees of the City of Berkeley to reside within the city during the tenure of their appointment unless residency is waived by the Council.

**WHEREAS**, the Council has found that this requirement limits qualified candidates from applying for available positions.

**Now, Therefore, Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Berkeley, Missouri, as follows:**

**Section 1** Ordinance 4327 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

**Section 2** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL NEW FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF BERKELEY TO RESIDE WITHIN THE CITY DURING THE TENURE OF THEIR APPOINTMENT UNLESS RESIDENCY IS WAIVED BY THE COUNCIL.**

Now, Therefore, Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Berkeley, Missouri, as follows:

**Section 1.** All new full time employees of the City shall reside within the City during the tenure of their appointment, provided however, that they shall be granted a six (6) month period to locate and reside within the City after their appointments.

**Section 2.** Failure to so locate and reside, and to thereafter continue to reside within the City shall cause a forfeiture of their employment.


**Section 3.** The Council, with majority vote, may waive the residency requirements.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.


