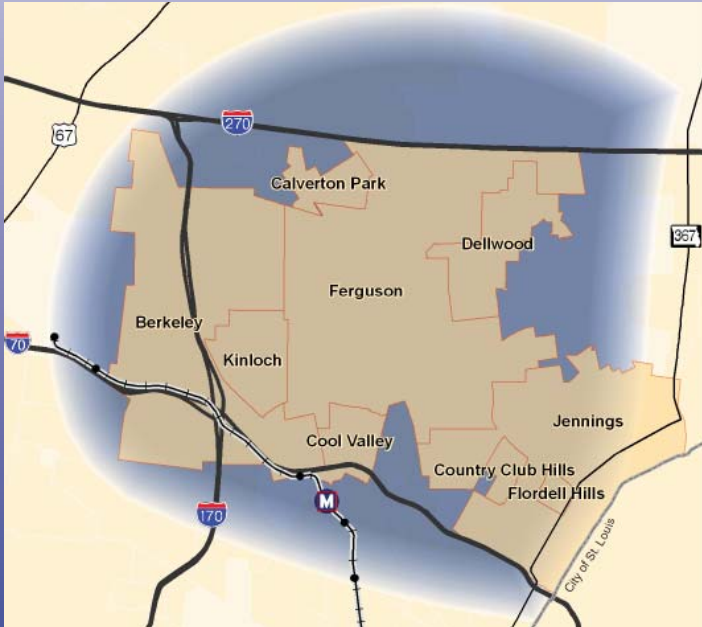




St. Louis Regional Sustainable Communities
