- Cadets must sign agreements for Berkeley paying the tuitions.
- Kelly days vs paid overtime and which is better for Berkeley Fire Department.
- In-house dispatching for the Fire Department.
- RFP needed for Health Care & Psychology services.
- Implement charge for non-residents serviced for EMS Care.
- Base salary adjustments for firefighters from Prop P funds. Contingency on balance budget and approval by the council.
- Uniforms program through vouchers.
- Safer Grant
- Crime Free Multi Housing Coordinator – Civilian position – works with inspectors, landlords, and police.
