AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF BERKELEY, MISSOURI, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT WITH IDEMIA FOR THE LIVSCAN 5-YEAR SUBSCRIPTION

Now, Therefore, Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Berkeley, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement with Idemia Identity & Security USA LLC for the police department 5-year livescan fingerprint subscription for an annual fee which does not increase for the life of the contract.

Section 2. The attached agreement is hereby incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance, as if fully set out herein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

FY20 New Agency or Replacement Livescan Application

As a result of the recent state legislative session, the Missouri State Highway Patrol (MSHP) has received an appropriation to assist local law enforcement agencies with costs associated with the purchase or lease of a livescan device. This application is for those agencies seeking to replace an aging or end of life livescan, in addition to agencies that do not currently possess livescan technology and wish to participate.

The application process will be open from **September 1, 2019 through November 30, 2019**.

- Complete and submit the application form to the following email address: livescans@mshp.dps.mo.gov.
- The application will be reviewed by MSHP staff to determine if the agency qualifies based on the application information submitted and past criminal card submissions to the Central Repository.
- The **maximum amount provided by the plan for the procurement of a livescan will not exceed \$6,625.00** for either a purchase or LAAS. The exception to this amount will be for any agency requiring a cabinet for the livescan, this additional one-time cost of the cabinet, manufactured by Missouri Vocational Enterprises, will be paid by the plan.
- All new livescan orders will be submitted to Idemia by December 31, 2019, to ensure delivery and installation prior to the end of the fiscal year.

As with any state appropriation, there is no guarantee future appropriations will be provided for purchase, lease, or maintenance of livescan devices. Acceptance of this assistance should be with the understanding your agency assumes responsibility for all future associated costs when purchasing a device with subsequent maintenance, or upon entering a LAAS contract with Idemia.

Agencies are strongly encouraged to consider pursuing a local ordinance that is allowed under 488.5026, RSMo. This statute allows the collection of a \$2.00 fee for every conviction in the jurisdiction for the purpose of maintaining "biometric verification systems". Jurisdictions that have enacted local ordinances pursuant to this statute have reported that the fees collected provide them with a funding stream for biometric-related expenses, which include livescan devices, Fast ID devices, maintenance/lease expenses, and network connectivity.

Livescan Expenditure Program FY20 LAAS Configuration Request

The Missouri State Livescan contract provides for a five-year live scan subscription option for Missouri law enforcement agencies through the state vendor, Idemia. To participate in the Livescan as a Service (LAAS) option, your agency would sign a 5-year livescan subscription contract with Idemia, agreeing to pay the annual subscription fee which does not increase for the life of the contract. If your agency wishes to renew at the end of the 5-year subscription, Idemia will replace your livescan with an upgraded configuration with the renewal of another 5-year contract. As a result of the recent state legislative session, the MSHP has received an appropriation to assist local law enforcement agencies with costs associated with the purchase or lease of a livescan device, with the maximum amount provided per agency of \$6,625 for FY20. Please note the Patrol will purchase a heavy-duty live scan cabinet if needed as a one-time cost and is not associated with the subscription fee.
