Councilwoman-at-Large Greene called the special meeting to order and request the reading of the notice at 1:26 pm.

Special Meeting Notice

City Manager Irvin, Assistant City Manager Gibson, Finance Director King, Interim Police Chief Jackson, and City Clerk Jones were in attendance.

City Manager Irvin and Finance Director King explained to the Council that the estimated construction cost for the community center has increased to \$12.5 million. The Project Manager cost will be 4-7% of the construction cost. The Architects cost will be 7% of the projected construction cost. This estimated cost does not include the \$2-\$3 million operations cost of the center. Stifel will only finance the max of \$8 million. A current desired location needs a flood study. To save on cost the building can be decreased from 50,000 sq. to 25,000 sq. The center will need to be able to generate sustaining income. A backup “B” location is needed.

Councilwoman-at-Large Green moved, Councilman Hindeleh seconded, and the motion carried to hold a special meeting on 12-17-19 @ 1pm to discuss the community center and budget. City Manager Irvin and Finance Director King was dismissed at 2:07 pm.

Councilman Hindeleh moved and Councilwoman Williams seconded the motion to hold a closed session for real estate. Roll Call: Mayor-Absent, Hoskins-Absent, Mitchell-Aye, Williams-Aye, Greene-Aye, Hindeleh-Aye and Anthony-Absent (Aye-4) motion passed. Assistant City Manager Gibson and Interim Police Chief Jackson were dismissed at 2:20pm.

Councilwoman-at-Large Greene opened the closed session at 2:32pm for real estate. Roll Call: Mayor-Absent, Hoskins-Absent, Mitchell-Aye, Williams-Aye, Greene-Aye, Hindeleh-Aye and Anthony-Absent. Quorum established. City Manager Irvin and City Clerk Jones were present.

No action accord during this session.

Councilwoman Mitchell moved, Councilman Hindeleh seconded, and the motion carried to adjourn the meeting at 2:55pm.
