

## ***Did You Know...***

**There is a Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Below are some important preventative actions you need to be aware of.**

.....Do the Five Steps to Help Stop Coronavirus

1. Hands: Wash your hands often with soap and water
2. Elbow: Cough and Sneeze into your elbows.
3. Face: Don't touch your eyes, nose, and mouth.
4. Feet: Stay more than 3ft apart (remember personal space)
5. Feel: Stay home if you feel sick.

.....There are people that are at higher risk of getting sick:

1. Seniors (over 60 years of age)
2. People with underlying health conditions including heart disease, lung disease, or diabetes.
3. People with weakened immune systems
4. People who are pregnant.

.....Do not go to the emergency room unless approved by your Doctor. If you feel sick or came in contact with a person who has COVID-19, call your Doctor.

.....Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

.....Do not attend functions with 10 or more people.

.....Do not open your doors to strangers or those you don't trust. Be aware of scammers.

.....The Police & Fire Departments will continue to function and adhering to precautions that are safer for all.
