- 2) Closed Session: Litigation-RSMo. 610.021(1), Real Estate-RSMo. 610.021(2), Personnel-RSMo. 610.021(3)

City Manager Irvin, Finance Director Camp, and City Clerk Jones were in attendance.

This is a summary of the items discussed in the budget meeting.

- Mayor Deinbo moved and Councilman Hindeleh seconded the motion to record the meetings. Roll Call: Mitchell-Aye, Williams-Absent for the vote, Hoskins-Absent, Anthony-Aye, Hindeleh-Aye, Greene-Aye, and Mayor-Aye (Aye-5) motion passed.
- Councilwoman-at-Large Greene moved, Councilwoman Anthony seconded, and the motion carried for the 2nd reading of Bill #4779 by title only. Question and Answer section allowed.
- Mayor want to see City Manager’s employee file.
- Ward 5 streets are scheduled in the next three year’s CDBG funding. Ward 2 will be slated as the first streets to be completed. Councilwoman Williams moved and Councilwoman Anthony seconded the motion giving the City Manager authority to move forward with fixing Hern Dr.
- City Manager report should be given weekly. This will exclude weeks with Holidays.
- Councilwoman Mitchell moved and Councilwoman Anthony seconded the motion for the 3rd reading, by title only, and adoption of Bill #4779. Roll Call: Mitchell-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Absent, Anthony-Aye, Hindeleh-Aye, Greene-Aye, and Mayor-Aye (Aye-6) motion passed. *Ordinance #4617*
- Councilman Hindeleh moved and Councilwoman Anthony seconded the motion to go into a closed session for personnel at 2:20pm. Roll Call: Mitchell-Aye, Williams-Aye, Hoskins-Absent, Anthony-Aye, Hindeleh-Aye, Greene-Aye, and Mayor-Aye (Aye-6) motion passed. No action was taken during the closed session. Councilwoman-at-Large Greene moved, Councilwoman Anthony seconded, and the motion carried to close the closed session at 2:43pm.
- Complaint received about barbequing outside, fireworks, and loud music from the house next door to Jody B’s.
